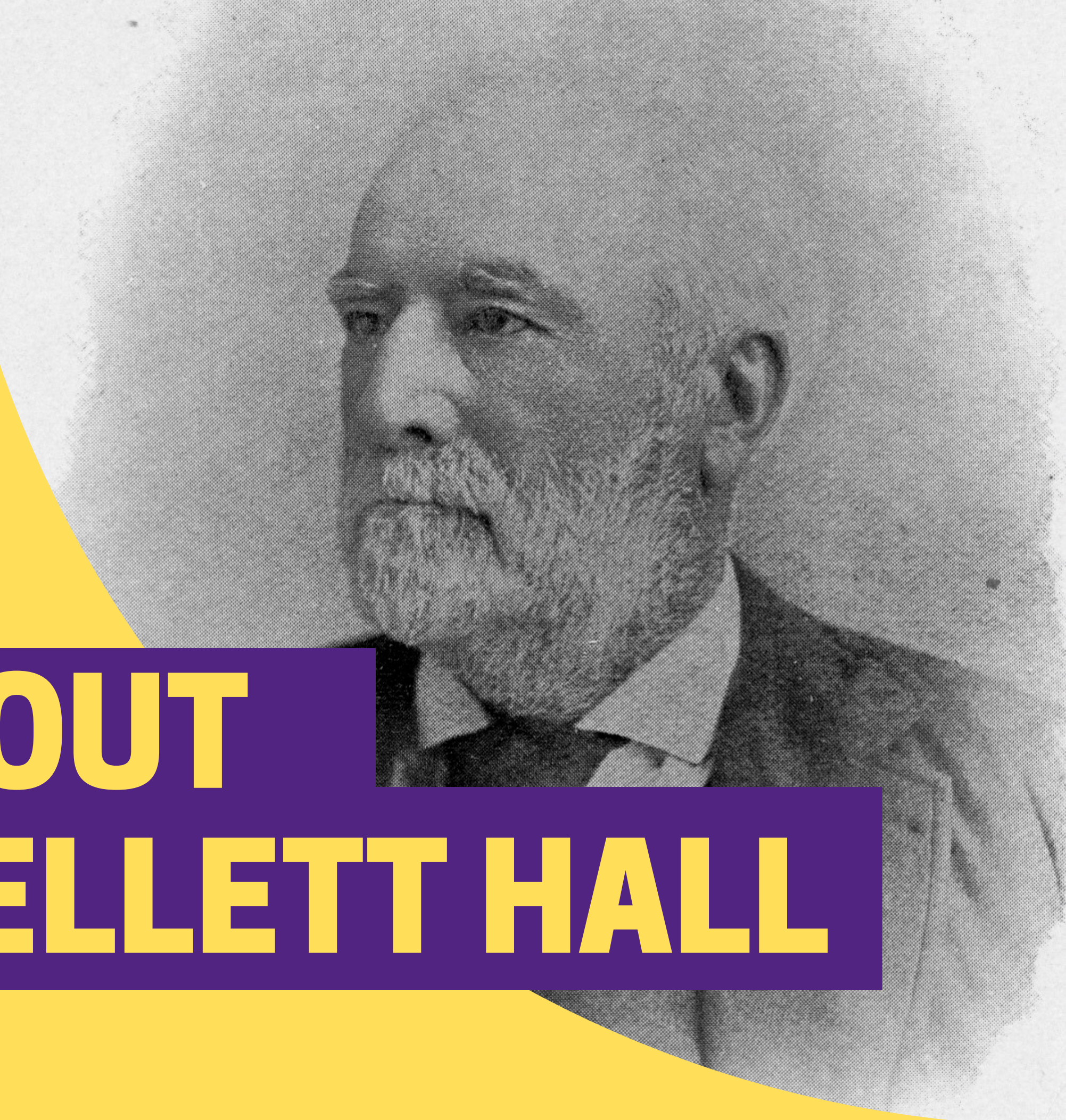

What is the story on Walsh-Ellett Hall?

Walsh Hall was constructed and dedicated between 1889-91.

Col. Vincent David Walsh of Louisiana, pledged over \$33,000 in 1889 in memory of his daughter, Susie Jessie.

During the Civil War, Walsh served as a colonel in the Confederate Military.

In 1860, Walsh's wealth was estimated at \$100,000, with \$90,000 of that equity based on the 79 persons he enslaved on his Louisiana cotton plantation.
